

MAKE AN APPOINTMENT NOW!

On December 20, President George W. Bush signed an executive order blocking a strike at United Airlines. His action sets the stage for Congress to become involved and forcibly impose a contract on thousands of IAM members at United Airlines.

If this President and his allies in Congress can set such a precedent at United Airlines, they won't stop there. Your right to bargain, your right to vote on a contract and your right to strike are under attack – whether or not you work for the airlines or in any other industry.

So it's time to fight back ... to react like the *Fighting Machinists* we are.

IAM members are being asked to make an appointment with their Senators and representatives in Congress. Over the next three weeks, IAM members should seek a specific commitment: Congress will not impose a contract on employees of a private company.

Make it clear to Congress your right to bargain, your right to vote on a contract and your right to strike are absolutely essential to your future.
